

### Privacy Policy

#### What are cookies ?

Cookies- small pieces of data sent from a website and stored in a user's web browser while a user is browsing a website. Cookies were designed to be a reliable mechanism for websites to remember the state of the website or activity the user had taken in the past. This can include clicking particular buttons, logging in, or a record of which pages were visited by the user even months or years ago.

It doesn't damage the operating system installed on your computer, nor does it affect its activity.

#### How our website uses cookies ?

Our website uses technology, in which it's necessary to use cookies- information stored by servers on the user's terminal device which servers can read each time you connect.

Our website stores information on the language selected by the user, and other information necessary for the smooth working.

#### The main purpose of using cookies

1)Adaptation of Web content to the website user preferences and optimizing the use of the website; in particular, it allows the user to identify the device and appropriately run a website, tailored to their individual needs

2)Creation statistics that help to understand how users use the service from web pages and prove their structure and content

3)Maintenance of the website user sessions (after logging in), so that you do not have service on every page re-enter login and password

4)Delivery of advertisement adjusted to user's interest

#### How does the browser use cookies ?

In many cases, software for browsing the web (browser) by default, allows storage of cookies on users' terminal device. Users may make at any time change the settings for cookies. These settings can be changed in particular in such a way as to block the automatic handling of cookies in the settings of your web browser or inform them each time of posting on your website. Detailed information about the possibilities and supporting of cookies settings are available in the software (web browser). Failure to change the settings of cookies means that they will be included in users' terminal device and then we will be storing the information on the users' terminal device and getting access to this information.

#### Can I turn off cookies ?

Turning off the use of cookies may cause difficulties in the use of our website. Disable cookies will not block browsing our website.

#### How to turn off cookies ?

If you think that the presence of cookies violates your privacy, you can always turn it off, or for a particular site or in general for all connections of your browser.

### 1) **Mozilla Firefox**

Go to Tools in the menu bar, click on Options and the Privacy tab. Browser gives you the opportunity to indicate that you do not want to be tracked at all or remove individual cookies each site.

#### 1) **Microsoft Internet Explorer**

Go to Tools in the menu bar, click on Options and the Privacy tab. You can adjust the overall level of privacy by the special slider or click "Sites" and manage settings for specific websites.

### 3) **Google Chrome**

Click on the spanner icon in the top right of the browser, "Options", "Under the Bonnet" (UK) / "Under the Hood" (US). Select "Content settings" button in the Privacy section and "Clear browsing data" button. In addition to turning off the cookies, there is a link "More information" that leads to a detailed description of the browser's privacy function.

### 4) **Opera**

To delete all cookies at the end of every session, select it in the privacy settings under "Tools" > "Preferences". Click on "Manage cookies" to delete specific cookies or cookies from specific domains. To delete all cookies immediately, go to "Delete private data" on the "Tools" menu.

### 5) **Apple Safari**

Go to the "Safari" menu (icon in top right of browser) and select "Preferences". In the popup window that appears, select the "Security" icon (a padlock). Under "Accept Cookies", select the "Never" button
